Due to fiscal consolidation issues in the last few years, Greece hasn't launched any call of proposals, since 2010 in order to finance programs in developing countries, handled by HELENIC AID/Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Greece. Most of the assistance was multilateral. Despite difficulties, in 2013 Greece has reached a level of 0.12% of Official Development Assistance (ODA)/GNI.
